Expected Questions to support adding '-s' to form plurals where words are decodable with knowledge of all year 1 phonetic sounds.

Greater Depth Questions to support adding '-s' to form plurals where nouns used are compound words, tricky words or multi-syllabic words and are used in full sentences.



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

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
Varied Fluency – Adding '-s' – Year 1 Developing
