





Hi! My name is Aisha. I am a Muslim. My place of worship is called a mosque. I like to go there with my family.


> It is huge and looks very grand from the outside. Not all mosques look as grand as the mosque where I go.

Hi! My name is Adam and I am Jewish. My place of worship is called a synagogue.




My family and I go to services here on Friday evenings, Saturdays and on festival days.


It is very big and very old. I think it is beautiful and peaceful inside.

- sometimes quiet.




