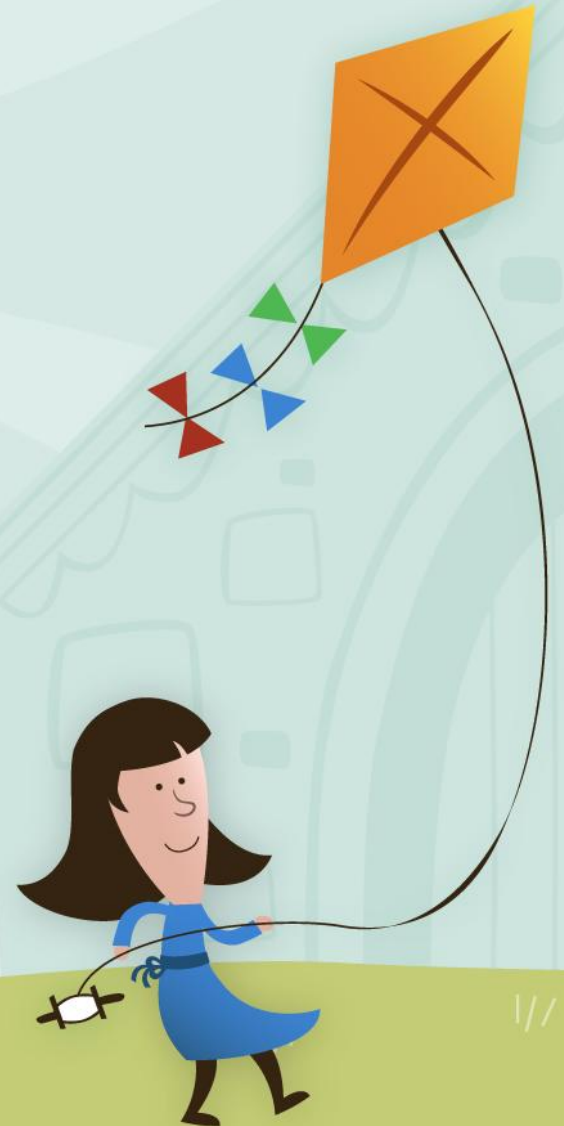


Welcome to Year 4 at Crestwood Park

Your Child's Curriculum Journey...

- History and Geography: Anglo Saxons and Vikings. Comparing North and South America. Local area study.
- Science: Electricity, animals including humans, sound. Living things and their habitats, states of matter
- Art: colour theory, shading and tone, tessellation, sewing, collagraph print, clay sculptures
- PE: gymnastics, dance, invasion games, bowling and striking games and net games
- PSHE: Communication skills, the environment, money management, growth and changes
- French: My birthday, my pets, what's in my school bag.



- RE: Judaism, religious festivals, Islam and the Quran, Christianity and love.
- D&T: Structures and packaging, textiles, making a salad.



READING CHALLENGE/COMPETITION!

Your child's reading record will be collected in on a Friday. For every time your child reads at home during the week, they will move up one space on the reading chart. Once your child reaches the end, they will get a prize.

Once your child feels they are confident with their home reading book they can complete their quiz on accelerated reader. They can do this quiz at home (please see reading record on how to do this) or in school and then they can change their books following the quiz.



Statutory Tests

- Each term children complete a reading and maths assessment.
- In the reading test, children will have a text and a question booklet. As well as a Spelling and a punctuation and grammar test.
- In maths, children will complete one arithmetic paper and one problem solving test.
- All big writes will be assessed using a grid in the back of their curriculum study books.
- Star reading assessments every half term and quizzes after completing a book.
