Reporting an Absence

If a child is poorly and not well enough to come into school, parents should inform us by 9:30am at the very latest. The absence will then be marked as 'I' for authorised absence due to illness. Parents are asked to inform school on each day of absence. If we receive no reason for an absence, we will telephone parents. If we have no response, we will send a notification via the sch.life app, reminding parents to call school. We will also try to contact the other contacts for the child as listed on our records. If we have no reason for an absence and this causes concern (for eg- if we feel there may be a safeguarding issue or the child is on our persistent absentee list), we will conduct a home visit so that we can see the child.
