## Step 2: Capital Letters for Dates 2

### Differentiation:

**Developing** Questions to support using capital letters for dates. Sentences include Phase 2/3 words that are CVC and CVCC/CCVC.

**Expected** Questions to support using capital letters for dates. Includes some instances of the correct use of 'I' elsewhere in the sentence. Sentences include Phase 5 and some common exception words.

**Greater Depth** Questions to support using capital letters for dates. Includes some instances of the correct use of 'I' and capitalised names elsewhere in the sentence. Sentences include Phase 5, polysyllabic words and common exception words.
