Parents must apply in writing if they want to take their child out of school. Forms are available from the school office. The Head Teacher may authorise absence in term time, in exceptional circumstances. The DfE does not consider 'a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance' however, parents must still inform school. Our stance is very much that holidays should not be taken in term time. This could result in a penalty notice. That said, we appreciate that there can sometimes be extenuating circumstances leading to a request, so the school will always look at each request individually.
