# Varied Fluency Step 3: Noun or Verb?

# **Teaching Note**

We recommend teaching the terminology of *noun* and verb in Year 1 so that children understand the difference between the word types and the jobs that they have within sentences. The resources for this step will include the terminology of *noun* and verb.

## Differentiation:

**Developing** Questions to support recognising nouns and verbs. Using CVC and CCVC/CVCC words.

Expected Questions to support recognising nouns and verbs. Using high frequency or phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Questions to support recognising nouns and verbs. Includes some compound nouns and irregular verbs. Using some words which are not easily decodable.







#### Developing

1a. verb – hop, skip; noun – pan, ball 2a. verb – swim; noun – girl 3a. sing

#### **Expected**

4a. verb – singing, eat; noun – bucket, spider
5a. Various answers, for example: verb – riding/cycling; noun – girl, bike
6a. dancing

#### <u>Greater Depth</u>

7a. verb – whisper, crawling, drinking; noun – ice cream, king, sand castle 8a. Various answers, for example: verb – skating, moving; noun – helmet, roller skates

9a. Painting; laughing. Paints can be either a noun or a verb, so can be ticked.

<u>Developing</u> 1b. verb – jump, run; noun – bun, sock 2b. verb – skip; noun – girl 3b. boy

#### **Expected**

4b. verb – shout, dancing; noun – baby, tree 5b. Various answers, for example: verb – swimming / snorkelling; noun – flippers, trunks, boy 6b. playing

#### Greater Depth

7b. verb – baking, screaming, creep;
noun – spider web, bear, bus stop
8b. Various answers, for example:
verb – spinning, standing; noun – boy, ball
9b. Swinging; smiling Swings can be either
a noun or a verb, so can be ticked.
