Differentiation:

Expected Identify if a sentence is a question or a statement. Sentences use vocabulary that is phonetically decodable using knowledge of all taught sounds needed for the phonics screening.

Greater Depth Identify if a sentence is a question or another type of sentence. Sentences use vocabulary that is made up of all taught sounds as well as words taken from the Year 1 spelling lists.
