## Year 5 – Spring Block 1 – Parenthesis – Using Commas to Indicate Parenthesis

## Notes and Guidance

- This step builds on the previous steps and looks at using commas to indicate parenthesis.
- Children should be able to demarcate parenthesis in different positions in a sentence, remembering to surround the parenthesis with commas mid-sentence.
- Children should remember to use a single comma to open parenthesis if adding an afterthought at the end of a sentence.
- Some children should be able to explain whether a comma has been used for an adverbial, a subordinate clause or in a list as well as using commas to indicate parenthesis. Normally, if a sentence uses a comma for any other reason, brackets or dashes are preferred to indicate parenthesis.
