

The Past Perfect Tense Bingo Game



We use the past perfect tense to talk about an event that was completed in the past before another event has taken place.

E.g. I had walked to the shop to buy a newspaper before I ate my breakfast

Rules:

Hand out the bingo cards below to each player and cut out the caller cards.

The bingo caller picks one caller card at a time and reads aloud the present tense of the verb.

Each player must convert the verb into the past perfect form, E.g. climb \rightarrow had climbed. If that verb tense is on your card, place a counter on it/ tick it.

Play continues until one player wins all the boxes on their bingo card. They must then create sentences using each of the past perfect tense verbs.
