Varied Fluency Step 4: Using the Past Perfect Form

National Curriculum Objectives:

English Year 5: (5G4.1b) <u>Using the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause</u>

Differentiation:

Developing Questions to support using the past perfect form of regular verbs within singleclause sentences. For example, I had practised all day.

Expected Questions to support using the past perfect form of regular and irregular verbs within multi-clause sentences. For example, As there was only one week until the tournament, I had practised all day.

Greater Depth Questions to support using the past perfect form of regular and irregular verbs within multi-clause sentences. Some sentences contain multiple verbs in the past perfect form, for example, As there was only one week until the exams, I had practised all day and (I had) revised all night. This also includes using the past perfect form in the negative, for example, I had never been so nervous.
