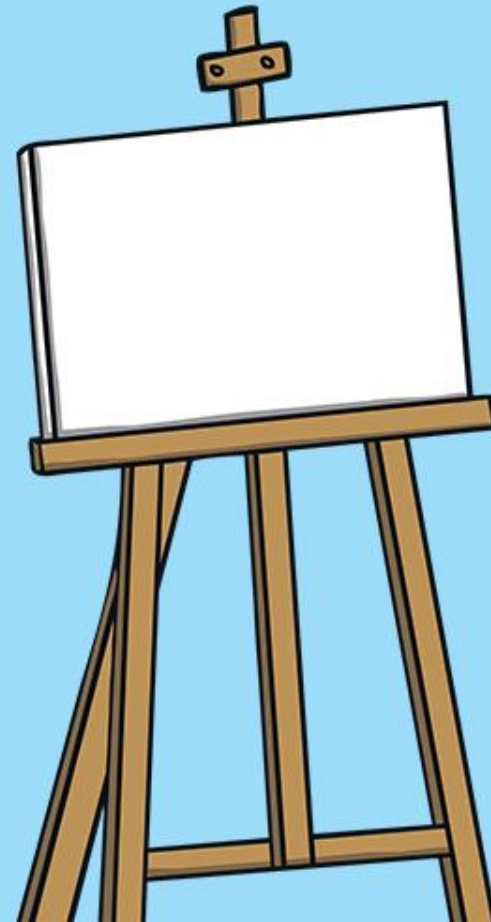


Bridget Riley

What Is Optical Art?

This is created by the use of pattern and colour.

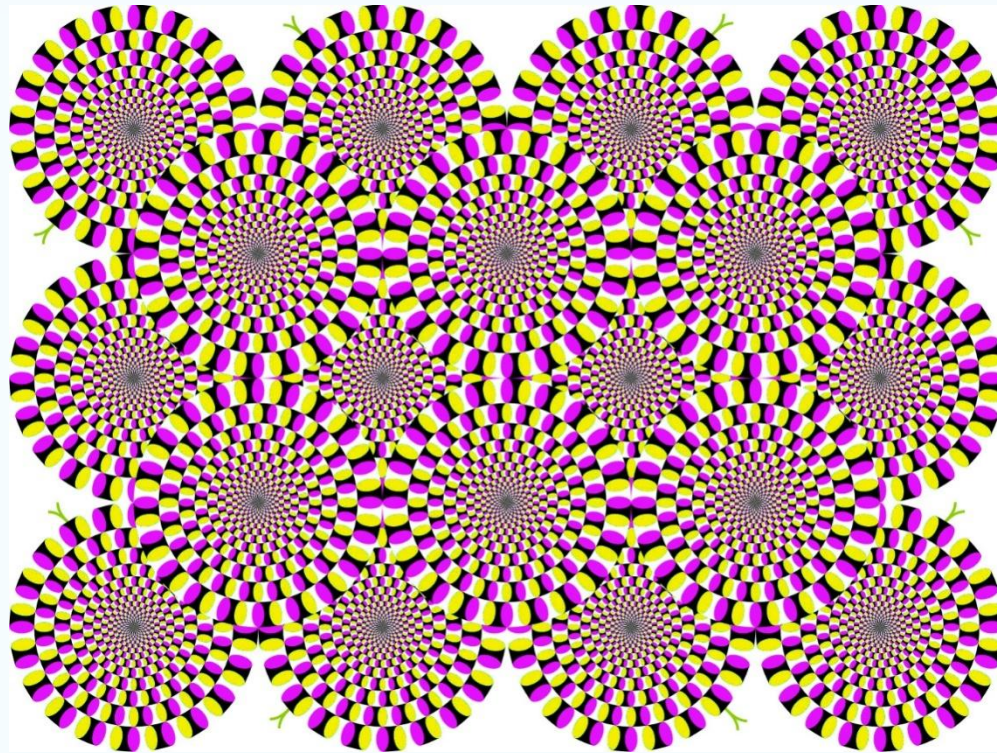

She went on to achieve a degree in art.
In her early career, she experimented with **pointillism**.
Shortly after, she began to develop her optical art style.

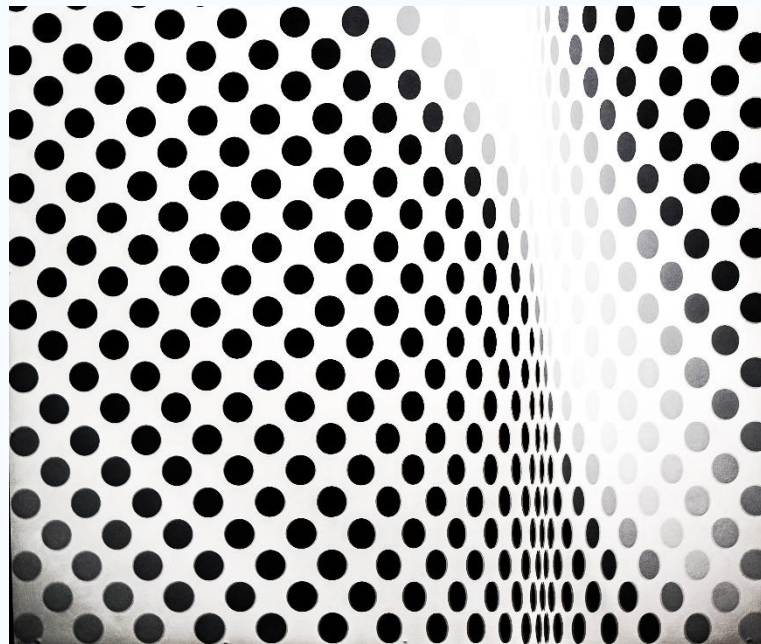
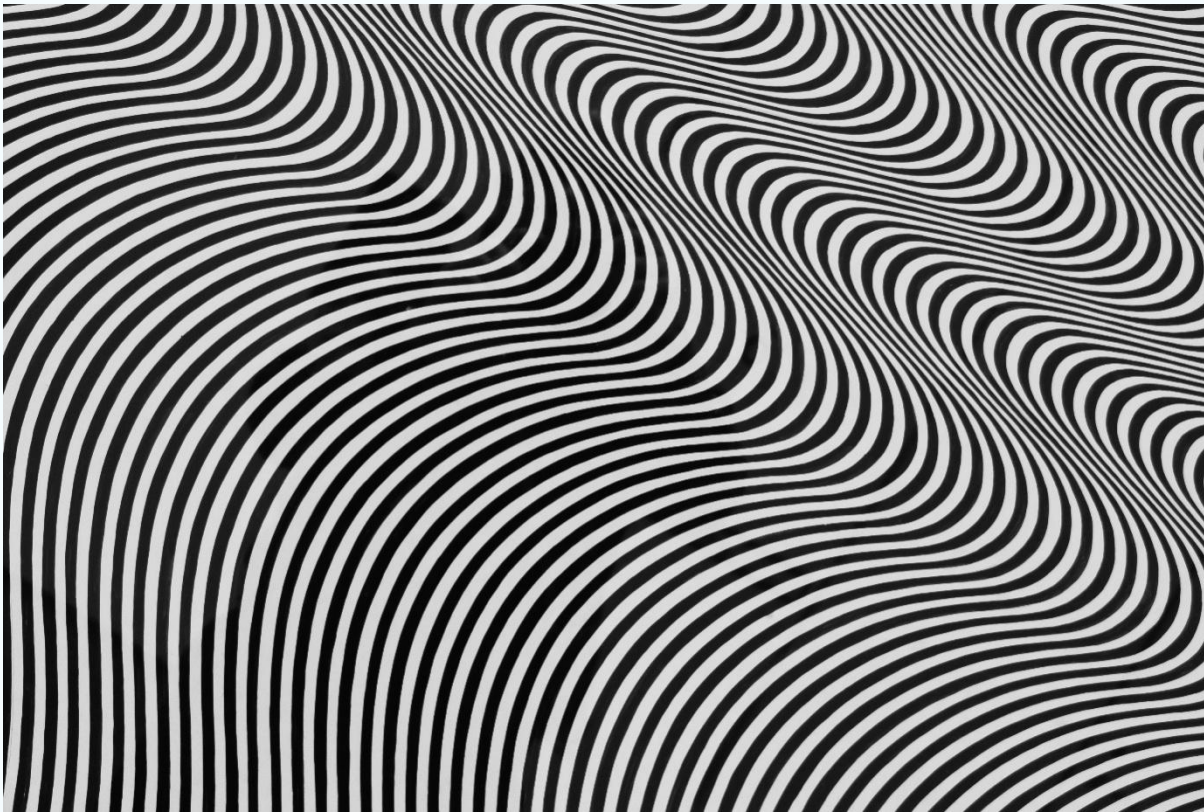

In the 1960s, she began to paint in black and white using geometric shapes.

In 1967, she began experimenting with colour and created her first stripe painting.

After visiting Egypt, she began to use other, brighter colours.

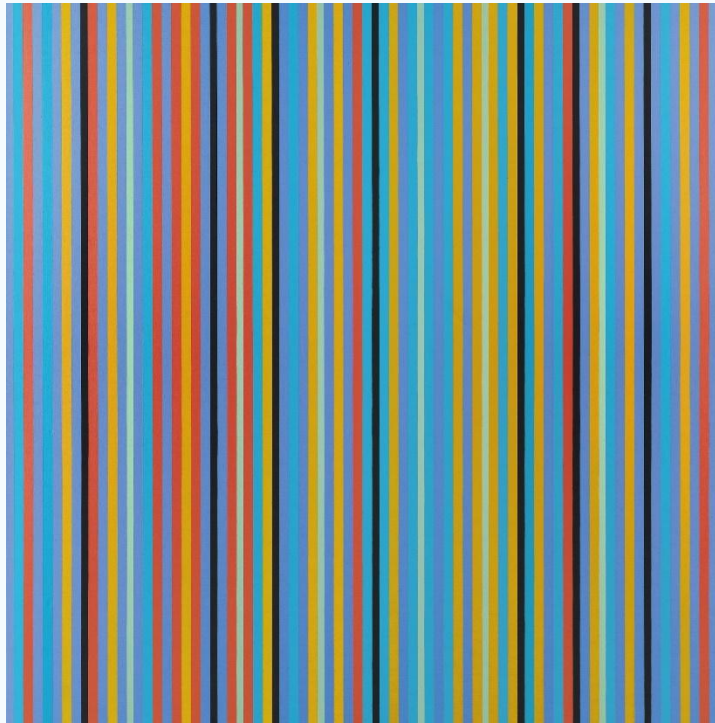

- Bridget Riley is still painting today.
- Her paintings are very large and often take between six and nine months to complete.
- She hand-mixes all of her paints.
- Everything is painted by hand; she does not use rulers.

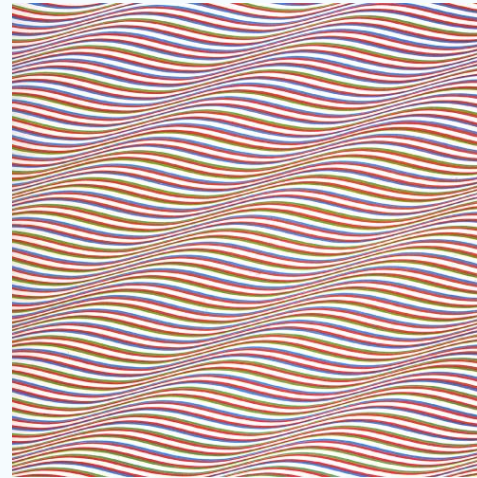
