
Your Child's Curriculum Journey...

- Creative curriculum: The Trojan Horse, The Mayans, Mountains and Rivers and Local area study.
- Science: Changes in state of materials, life cycles, Space and forces.
- Art: colour theory, sketching using perspective, optical illusions, sewing patterns, sculpting and lino printing.

Statutory Tests
