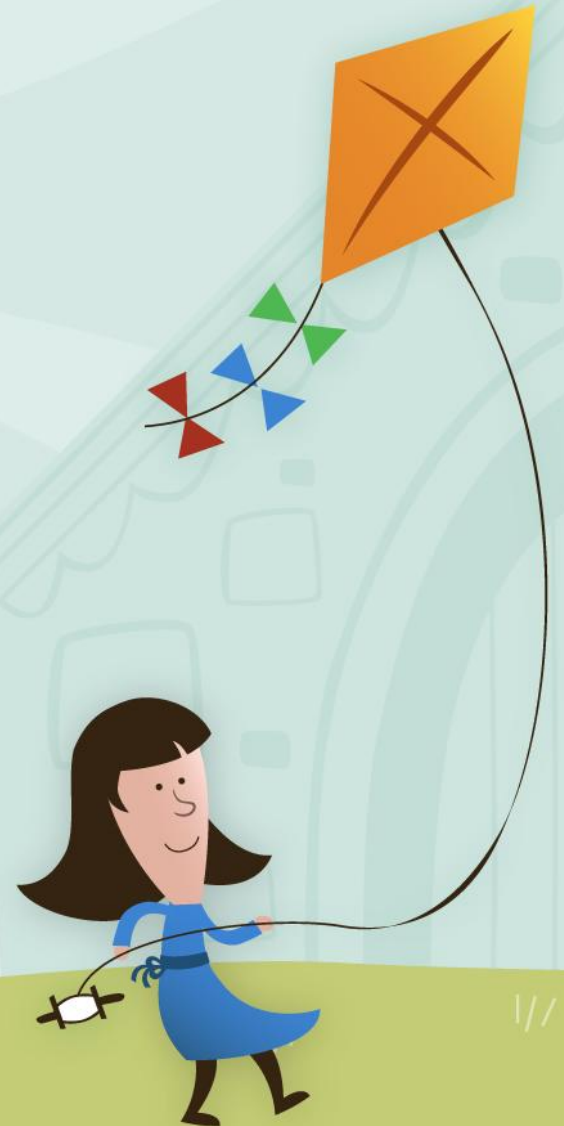

- Thursday 13th – Maths: Reasoning

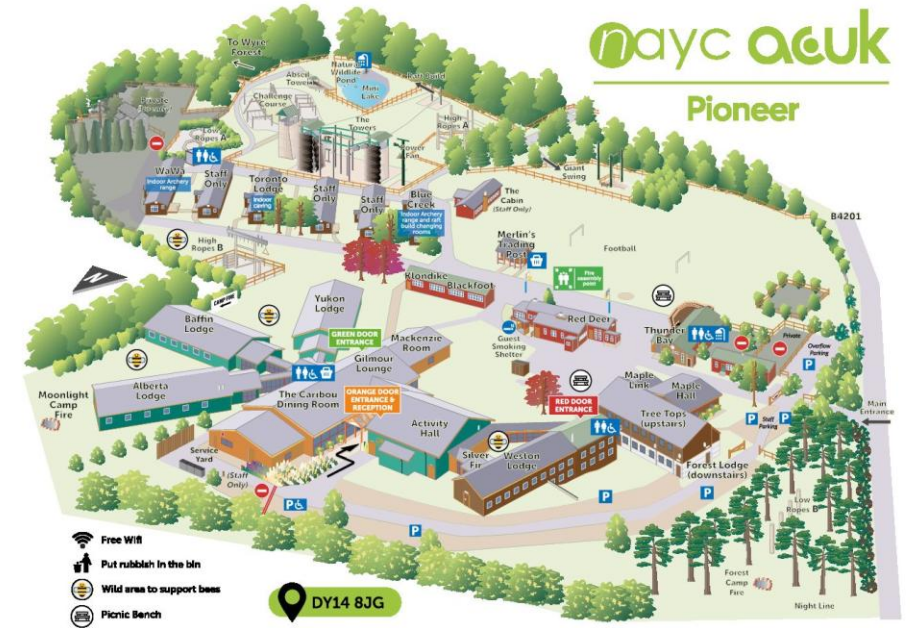

- Support with homework. Let them have a go, support where you can and ask them to see us to if they are still unsure.
- Look out for letters regarding SATS clubs — these are after school to support your child.
